# Type of Visa

## Which visa do I need to apply for?

As a student in Australia, you will need to apply for a <u>Student Visa (Subclass 500)</u>. If you need more information, please see the <u>Australian Dept.</u> of <u>Immigration and Border Protection website</u>.

How much will it cost?

Visa fees are always subject to change. Please check here for the most up to date visa fees.

#### How do I apply for a student visa?

All student visa applications will be made online.

# Visa Requirements

Visa requirements are subject to Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 of the Migration Legislation. This criteria is based on satisfying the following criteria, amongst others:

- Evidence of enrolment
- Financial documents and satisfying the delegate that you are a
  Genuine Temporary Entrant (GTE) criteria as set by <u>direction 69</u> under § 499 of the Act

#### What do I need to lodge an application?

- Confirmation of Enrollment (eCOE)- Swinburne International will supply this document. It will be emailed to you. Please check your husky email and spam folders. You must complete all N.U.in Enrollment forms to obtain ecOE.
- 2. Passport

- 3. Payment- Credit card
- 4. Any other documentation required by immigration

Please use the <u>Document Checklist Tool</u> provided by the Australian Department of Immigration and Border of Protection to guide you as you collect documentation.

## How do I attach supporting documents to my online application?

You can attach additional documents to your application by following these instructions.

#### How do I check the progress of my application?

You are able to check the status of the application through the <u>Electronic Application Status Inquiry</u> page. To access the page, you will need to have your ImmiAccount username and password.

#### How do I continue a saved application?

To continue a saved application, the system will require you to log in to your ImmiAccount through <u>this</u> page.

## How can I change my address and passport details?

Please visit this page, and use the appropriate form to notify the Department of Immigration and Border Protection about any changes or a new passport.

## What if I'm under 18 years old at the time of application?

All student visa holders are subject to conditions.

Students under 18 years old at the time of application are required to provide extra documentation when applying for a student visa, including <u>Form 157N Nomination of a student guardian (178KB PDF)</u> and <u>Form 1229</u> Consent to grant an Australian visa for a child under 18 years. See <u>more details on additional</u> requirements.

Students under 18 must also complete Swinburne's Underage Student Agreement, found in their myNEU portal.

#### How long will it take for my visa to be issued?

May I work or change programs while in Australia?

All student visa holders are subject to conditions.

Under the terms of your visa you are not allowed to work more than 40 hours for every 2 weeks and we highly discourage any employment. You are not allowed to change education providers while in Australia as this may be deemed a breach of your visa.

## What is **PIC 4020**?

A visa applicant is responsible to provide correct information and genuine documents to support a visa application

Incorrect information whether knowingly or unknowingly can invoke PIC 4020, which carries a 3 year ban.
